- ◆ Reviewed and elaborated findings with the stakeholders, and developed an actionable roadmap for tackling the identified challenges and issues.
- ◆ Provided training and knowledge transfer regarding the implementation of agile software development and software product line engineering approaches.
- ◆ Defined a disciplined agile software development process that explicitly addresses the role of a Platform Team and the interaction between Web development projects and the platform development stream.

## Big data

**Databases:** Implementation of relational databases, graph databases, key value stores, selection and implementation of cloud storage solutions and enterprise content management solutions, database performance analysis and tuning.

### Small data

**Information architecture development:** Enterprise data modelling, schema modularisation, semantic data integration, metadata management, implementation of role based access control.

## Data quality assurance

**Quality maintenance:** Data quality analysis, master data management, data integrity validation and reconstruction, data cleansing, design and implementation of document management and record management solutions.
